About the Project

Barangay Bacan is an adopted barangay for the extension activities of the College of Teacher Education. Since the college has its expertise in building the capability of people, its aim is to work towards quality education and concerns on environmental conservation, with gender and development advocacy. In 2006- 2009, the college has implemented Literacy Enhancement and Health Watch Projects in Bacan Elementary School with Grades V & VI pupils as beneficiaries. The tutorial classes in Mathematics, English, Science and Social Studies subjects conducted by the Pre-Service Teachers and CTE Faculty who served as mentors had contributed much to a high achievement of the Grade VI pupils in the National Achievement Test (NAT) given by the DepEd at the end of the school year and putting the school to top 1 in the district rank. The CTE's successful experience in providing literacy enhancement and health watch to pupils of Bacan Elementary School gave the impetus to replicate the project in Bacan National High School. However, instead of just focusing on the students, this time, the teachers were also identified as clientele. Upgrading and enhancing the quality of the teachers would result to their improved teaching performance, and ultimately, this would be reflected in the students' academic performance. Even Thus, an extension program entitled "Education for Lifelong Human Capability Enhancement" (ELHCE) has been conceptualized.
